

Path Number	Legal Designation	Location
TEFF1	Footpath	Stretches between Hindon Road (B3089) on the western exit of the village and CHIL6 - Chilmark
TEFF2	Footpath	From The Street (B3089) behind Bathurst Cottage leading south-west to TEFF15
TEFF3	Bridleway	Starts at Holt Lane in Evias heading west before joining TEFF15 and CHIL6
TEFF4	Footpath	Between Hindon Road B3089 at the western exit of the village and the C277 near Springhead
TEFF5	Bridleway	Between the C277 in Magna at Manor Farm Cottages, leading north-east across the Ox Drove- TEFF12 until it meets Wylze - WYLY4
TEFF6	Bridleway	Known as dark lane or the coffin trail. Begins at The Street (B3089) between Corrindale and The Birches and meets with TEFF8
TEFF7	Footpath	From The Street (B3089) near Lintern Close and Holt View until TEFF6
TEFF8	Bridleway	Between the Old Dinton Road C277 at Sandyhills and Dinton Park
TEFF9	Restricted Byway	Runs north between the Old Dinton Road C277 at Hillcrest and The Ox Drove- TEFF12
TEFF10	Bridleway	Between TEFF13 near the old Lime Kiln and Chilmark- CHIL17
TEFF11	Footpath	South of the Level Crossing meeting TEFF14 at Mill Farm, skirting around Mill Farm until it meets FOVA2 at Fovant
TEFF12	Byway	From CHIL13 to the west to DINT10 to the east. It is the northern boundary of the village Known as The Ox Drove- open to all traffic
TEFF13	Footpath	From Holt Lane, crosses TEFF10 near the old Lime Kiln, continues until it reaches the Tisbury Road that approaches Ley Barn- C.24 and leaves C.24 46m south-west continuing south and south-west by the River Nadder to the Tisbury (Sutton Mandeville) parish boundary by the railway.
TEFF14	Footpath	Fovant Parish boundary south of Mill Farm to TEFF11 then north-east under the railway line via underpass to Edwards Copse near Oakley Farm where it meets DINT3 -Dinton
TEFF15	Footpath	Between TEFF1 and TEFF2 where it meets CHIL6

DESIGNATION	Who can use the route – general guidance
Public Right of Way	A route over privately or publicly owned land that the public has a legally protected right to use. In England and Wales
FOOTPATH (FP)	 Pedestrians: Walking or running  Dogs: provided they are under proper control and subject to any local restrictions.  Mobility scooters/powerful wheelchairs
BRIDLEWAY (BR)	 Pedestrians  People walking dogs , subject to the usual control requirements  Horse riders  Cyclists  Mobility scooters/powerful wheelchairs
RESTRICTED BYWAY (RBY)	 Pedestrians  Dogs: provided they are under proper control and subject to any local restrictions  Horse riders  Cyclists  Mobility scooters/powerful wheelchairs  Users of non-mechanically propelled vehicles (for example, horse-drawn carriages)
BOAT -Byway Open to All Traffic	All the above + motor vehicles
